## DISTRICT OF SOUTH HAMS (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)

### (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2010

South Hams District Council proposes to make the following changes to its off-street car parking conditions by altering the conditions in the District of South Hams (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1999 ("the Principal Order"):

- (a) To add 'Motor homes' to the classes of vehicles allowed in the following car parks as set out in the Schedule:

- Item 4. Kingsbridge, Cattle Market Car Park**
- Item 11F. Dartmouth, Park and Ride**
- Item 16. Totnes, Longmarsh Car Park**
- Item 22. Slapton, Memorial Car Park**
- Item 25. Ivybridge, Leonards Road Car Park**
- Item 28A. Modbury, Poundwell Meadow over flow Car Park**

Scale of charges:

- Motor homes to purchase two tickets where the length of the vehicle means it overhangs a second bay (at the rear)
- Motor homes to purchase two tickets where the width of the vehicle means it overhangs a second bay (at the side)

The motor home may be parked for a maximum of 24 hours.

No vehicle of any type may be used for sleeping.

To amend Definitions under section 2(2) of the principal Order as follows:

"Definition' of motor home means 'a motor vehicle which is constructed or adapted for the carriage of passengers and their effects and which contains as permanently installed equipment, the facilities which are reasonably necessary for enabling the vehicle to provide living accommodation for its users'."

- (b) **Kingsbridge**

**Item 3A. Quay Car Park**

That the policy of allowing Leisure parking permits to be valid in the Quay Car Park, Kingsbridge, is withdrawn. Such permits will now only be valid in Cattle Market Car Park, Kingsbridge.

**Item 3C. Quay Slipway**

To amend the class of motor vehicles permitted to cark on the Quay Slipway to include detached trailers but subject to express permission being granted by the Council (via the Harbour Office).

No charge will be levied for parking but waiting will be limited to maximum of 1 hour and be for the purpose of launching boats.

- (d) **Item 3D. Quayside Leisure Centre** to be removed from the Schedule of the parking order as the Centre is no longer part of the Council's Car Park

- (e) **Item 16. Totnes Longmarsh**

Amend classes of vehicle in the schedule to:

All motor vehicle in classes (i) (ii) (iii) so as to allow boat trailers.

Amend 'Position of which vehicles may wait' to:

"such number of bays so as to accommodate the vehicle."

Scale of charges: to purchase two tickets where the length of the vehicle means it overhangs a second bay (at the rear)

- (f) **Item 26 Ivybridge - Glanvilles Mill Car Park**

- Alter schedule add class of vehicle to include Hackney carriages
- Hackney carriages allowed to park wholly within the bays marked for 'taxis'
- all year including Sundays and Bank Holidays
- 24 hours a day
- only whilst Hackney carriage driver is in attendance
- free of charge for Hackney carriages
- private vehicles are not allowed to park within the marked taxi bays
- Hackney carriages parked in non taxi parking bays must pay and display a valid parking ticket.

- (g) **Item 43. Holbeton Car Park**

The name on the Schedule be amended from 'Holberton' to 'Holbeton'.

- (h) **Item 46. East Allington Car Park**

The following location be added to the Schedule to the Parking Places Order:

Name of parking place: East Allington Car Park

Position of which vehicles may wait: wholly within a single parking bay

Classes of vehicles: All motor vehicles displaying a valid road fund license not having a trailer attached - classes (i) (ii) (iii)

Days of operation of parking space: All year including Sundays and Bank holidays

Hours of operation of parking place: 24 hours a day

Maximum period for which vehicles may wait: All day

Scale of charges: no charge

The Council proposes to make these changes by amending The District of South Hams (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1999, using their statutory powers, including those under Sections 35(1), (3), (3A), and 35C of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and paragraph 27 of the Ninth Schedule to that Act and paragraph 25 of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996.

Full details of the proposals, which are intended to come into effect on 25 March 2010, can be seen in the draft Order, available at Reception at Follaton House on Mondays to Thursdays from 8.30 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Fridays from 8.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m.
