

Local Housing Allowance is a way of working out the maximum Benefit that might be paid for tenants renting accommodation from a private landlord.

It only applies to those making claims for Housing Benefit or those already claiming who move to privately rented accommodation, on or after 7th April 2008.

The table below shows the weekly Local Housing Allowance rates for the South Hams area:

The Broad Rental Market Area you live in is determined by your postcode and you can contact the Council to find out whether you are in the Devon South or Plymouth area. The Local Housing Allowance figure is shown above. This is for information only. Local Housing Allowance payments are made 2 weekly in arrears.

A rough guide to the number of bedrooms available to you is one bedroom for:

- Each adult couple
- Any other adult (aged 16 or over) in the property
- Any two children of the same sex aged up to 15
- Any two children under 10
- Any other child

Note: single claimants under 25 and single claimants who are joint tenants are covered by different rules. Please contact us to find out more. The maximum number of bedrooms allowed is four.
