



Dartmouth Regatta 2011

Parking information



The main days of the Regatta are from Wednesday 24th to Saturday 27th August.

The fair will be using the Mayors Avenue car park during the Regatta, therefore from the 20th August this car park will be closed. Alternative car parking will be in the nearby Coronation Park. **Cars left in the closed Mayors Avenue car park will be removed by the council's contractors.** The police will be informed of their new location.

Parking in the town

A traffic regulation order will be in operation between Tuesday 23rd and 28th in Dartmouth town. Parking in the main roads of the town will be strictly curtailed in order to ensure the free flow of traffic and the free flow of the park and ride buses.

Do not park in these restricted areas.

This restriction also applies to Blue Badge holders.

Local radio stations will be asked to broadcast traffic updates.

Coronation Park

Between the 20th August and midnight 23rd August there will be areas set aside for Pay and Display users, Reserved Parking Permits, other permits normally valid in Mayors Avenue and Disabled Badge holders.

From Wednesday 24th August there will be no Pay and Display access. However, parking areas will be provided for Reserved Permits holders, Blue Badge holders and other permit holders only. From 20th to 28th of August, Coronation Park will be managed by the regatta committee. **There is limited capacity at this site.**

Blue Badge holders

There will be a limited free area in Coronation Park in the town centre for Blue Badge holders. It is likely that these will fill up very quickly.

There will also be extra Blue Badge spaces set aside in the main Park and Ride car park, at the roundabout, where the £10 Park and Ride charge applies. Even when this car park is marked full there may still be spaces available for blue badge holders



When all these areas are full there will be no specific Blue Badge facilities in the over flow fields at Venn lane. Disabled badge holders are welcome here but will have to make their own judgement whether to use these fields.

Park and Ride

From 24th August to 27th August an enhanced Park and Ride service will operate:

24th August from 8am to 10pm

25th August: from 8am to 11pm

26th August: from 8am to 11pm

27th August: from 8am to midnight

Overflow car park

When the main Park and Ride car park is full an overflow car park will be opened at the fields at the junction with Venn Lane on the A3122. This is about half a mile from the main Park and Ride roundabout. The entrance will be controlled by temporary traffic lights.

These will only open when needed. Buses will also operate from these fields. In the event of very wet weather these fields may be closed. If such a decision is made the the local radio will be informed

When these fields are full the police will be informed and they are likely to divert incoming traffic away from Dartmouth.

Charges

Between 24th and 27th August charges for Park and Ride operated by South Hams District Council will be £10 cash per car per day.

- Tickets will be issued on entry and should be shown to the bus drivers.
- Those holding Weekly Park and Ride Tickets will be accepted.
- Bus passes are not valid.
