| Summary of Progress             | <p><b>Key projects identified as:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Support South Devon Rural Transport Partnership</u>: especially in relation to innovative projects that improve access to services such as Shopmobility, Wheels to Work and transport leaflets. Potential projects where partners will be invited to get involved include: car sharing, assisting partners with travel plans.</li> <li>• <u>Support community-based planning</u>: especially in those areas not yet engaged, providing responses to new plans as they emerge, the creation of the community planning database.
