## Notes

1. The controlled Waste Regulations 1992, Schedule 2. Types of household waste for which a charge for collection may be made sets out a list in numeric order. For the purposes of this list of charges the same numbering order has been followed.
2. For the purposes of this charge a hotel means an establishment held out by the proprietor as offering food, drink and, if so required, sleeping accommodation, without special contract, to any traveller presenting himself who appears able and willing to pay a reasonable sum for the services and facilities provided and who is in a fit state to be received.
