POLITICAL GROUPS

(a) Formation of Political Groups

Notification had been received of the formation of three political groups on the Council, these being the Conservative Group with 27 Members, the Liberal Democrat Group with 9 Members and the Independent Group with 3 Members. One Member was not-aligned to any political group and wished to be referred to as a Tory Councillor.

(b) Representation of Political Groups on Bodies of the Council

The Chairman advised Members that a review of the representation of the political groups on the Council's Bodies had been carried out in consultation with the Leaders of the Political Groups.

Regarding the Salcombe Harbour Board, the Council had previously agreed to disapply the rules on political balance and the new Council would be required to reaffirm this.

The Chairman then reminded Members that the number of seats on the Council's Bodies was set by the Constitution, with the exception of the Development Control Committee. In June 2001, the Council decided that the size of the Development Control Committee was to be reviewed annually. In view of the nominations submitted by the Leaders of the Political Groups, a Committee of 21 Members was being recommended with a quorum of 11.

RESOLVED

1. That the allocation of seats on Council Bodies, as agreed with the Leaders of the Political Groups, be approved;
2. That the political balance rules are disappplied in the case of the Elected Member representation on the Salcombe Harbour Board;
3. That the number of seats on the Development Control Committee be approved at 21.

This was considered urgent in view of the need for the Council to issue a position statement in view of the announcement. This would be considered as item 19 (see 17/07 below).

Cllrs J Brazil, P H Cook, G J Fielden and C M Pannell declared personal interests in item 24, Gambling Act 2005 – Setting of Premises Licence Fees for 2007 / 2008 (see 20/07 below) arising from their connection with licensed premises. All remained for the discussion and vote on this matter.

16/07 CHAIRMAN'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Council noted a list of Civic Engagements attended by the previous Chairman.

17/07 DAIRY CREST, TOTNES – POTENTIAL CLOSURE ANNOUNCEMENT

In light of the recent announcement by the Dairy Crest Group Plc of the beginning of a 90 day consultation preceding the possible closure of its Totnes site, a Member commented on the importance for the Council to do all it could to prevent the closure. Should this not be possible, the Member wished to ensure that the site was retained for employment use.

The Leader of the Council advised that the Council wished to see Dairy Crest remain on the site, however a task force had been established, including key stakeholders, with the intention of trying to reduce the impact on the area if Dairy Crest decided to close the site. An Economic Impact Assessment had been commissioned to assess the scale of the impact if the site closes. He further advised that the site was protected for employment use within the adopted local plan.

Local Ward Members referred to the previous closure of other major employers in the town and the detrimental impact locally on employment and supporting businesses.

18/07

POST OF CHIEF EXECUTIVE

Consideration was given to a report which outlined the proposals of the Member Working Group on the arrangements for an Interim Chief Executive.

RESOLVED

That:-

1. the recommendation of the Member Working Group for the Council to adopt a shared Chief Executive, be supported and that David Incoll, currently Chief Executive of West Devon Borough Council, be confirmed as Interim Chief Executive and Head of Paid Service for this Council;
2. the terms of the interim arrangement to take the form of a secondment of David Incoll to this Council on the terms detailed in the Appendix to the report to the Council;
3. the interim arrangements to run for an initial period of nine months from 4 June 2007;
4. a Joint Monitoring and Review Group be established with West Devon Borough Council to oversee the arrangement. The Group's membership and terms of reference to be in accordance with Paragraphs 11 and 12 of the report to the Council;
5. the Strategic Director (Resources) be appointed as Electoral Registration and Electoral Returning Officer for the duration of the arrangement.

PERFORMANCE PLAN

A report was considered on the draft Performance Plan which sought approval for publication in June 2007 in accordance with the statutory requirement.

During discussion, reference was made to:-

- (i) the need for textual amendments, including reference to the recent election and the Council's partnership with Tadpool. Members were asked to submit further comments to officers;
- (ii) a Member's desire to see the corporate standards include a target for responses to e-mails and a reduction in unanswered calls. Members were advised that a new telephone system would soon be installed within the Customer Services Team which would help to ensure that the standards were achieved.
