1. Licensing Officer's Report

The Legal Executive presented the report and outlined the application before the Sub-Committee. It was noted that representations had been received in relation to the original application. The operating schedules had been amended after mediation with interested parties and it had been agreed that there should not be a formal hearing.

2. Committee's Deliberations

The Sub-Committee asked the Officers if all those who had originally objected to the operating schedule were now content with the proposed amendments to the operating schedule. The Legal Executive confirmed that this was the case.
