**LSC.13/08 DETERMINATION OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE UNDER THE LICENSING ACT 2003: ROYAL OAK INN, STATION ROAD, SOUTH BRENT TQ10 9BE**

**1. Licensing Officer's Report**

The Licensing Officer presented the report and outlined the application before the Sub-Committee. It was noted that one representation had been received in relation to the original application. The operating schedules had been amended after mediation with interested parties and it had been agreed that there should not be a formal hearing.

The following application was considered:

Royal Oak Inn, Station Road, South Brent, TQ10 9BE

**2. Committee's Deliberations**

The Sub-Committee asked the Officers if those who had originally objected to the operating schedule were now content with the proposed amendments. The Licensing Officer confirmed that this was the case.

During discussion, particular reference was made to:-

- (a) variations to the timings contained within the Premises License. The Licensing Manager detailed to the Sub-Committee that there were some minor variations proposed to the License. Members were informed that there were no objections to these variations and the License could again be reviewed if any complaints were to arise;
- (b) the exhibition of films. For clarity, the Licensing Manager advised that this was a mandatory condition and videos could not be shown which were not prescribed by the film classification body.

### **3. The Decision**

The Chairman announced the decision:

“We have considered the application to grant a variation to a new premises license.

We have considered the Statement of Licensing Policy, the government guidance and our obligations that relate to the promotion of the four licensing objectives.

We note the revised operating schedules submitted, and that all parties are in agreement that a hearing is not necessary.

It is our decision therefore to grant the license subject to the amended operating schedule”.
