**LSC.34/07 DETERMINATION OF AN APPLICATION FOR A NEW
PREMISES LICENCE UNDER THE LICENSING ACT 2003:
THE CAFÉ/DELICATESSEN, AVON MILL GARDEN CENTRE,
LODDISWELL, KINGSBRIDGE.**

1. Licensing Officer's Report

The Licensing Officer presented the report and outlined the application before the Sub-Committee. It was noted that representations had been received in relation to the original application. The operating schedules had been amended after mediation with interested parties and it had been agreed that there should not be a formal hearing.

The following application was considered:

The Café/Delicatessen, Avon Mill Garden Centre, Loddiswell, Kingsbridge, TQ7 4DD.

A Member questioned the variation between the closing hours of the garden centre and the supply of alcohol stoppage time. In response, officers informed Members that such a variation was to avoid any requirement for a Temporary Events Notice.

Committee's Deliberations

The Sub-Committee asked the Licensing Officer if all those who had originally objected to the operating schedule were now content with the proposed amendments to it and whether all had agreed that there should not be a formal hearing. The Licensing Officer confirmed that this was the case.

2. The Decision

The Chairman proceeded to announce the decision, as follows:
