**LSC.3/06 CONSIDERATION OF AN APPLICATION FOR A VARIATION
OF A PREMISES LICENCE UNDER THE LICENSING ACT
2003: THE MOUNTAIN INN, LUTTON.**

1. Licensing Officer's Report

The Licensing Assistant presented her report and outlined the application
before the Sub-Committee. There were representations from Devon and
Cornwall Constabulary in respect of the variation. The operating schedules
had been amended after mediation with the Police and all parties had agreed
that there should not be a formal hearing.

The following application was considered:

The Mountain inn, Lutton.

2. Committee's Deliberations

The Sub-Committee asked the Licensing Assistant if all those who originally
objected to the operating schedule were now content with the proposed
amendments to the operating schedule and whether all had agreed that there
should not be a formal hearing. The Licensing Assistant confirmed that this
was the case.

3. The Decision

The Chairman announced the decision:

“We have considered the application to grant a variation to the existing premises licence.

We have considered our own Statement of Licensing Policy, the guidance and our obligations that relate to promoting the four licensing objectives.

We note the revised operating schedules submitted as amended and that all parties are in agreement that a hearing is not necessary.

It is our decision therefore, to grant the licence subject to the amended operating schedules”.
