LSC.6/09 DETERMINATION OF AN APPLICATION FOR A NEW PREMISES LICENCE UNDER THE LICENSING ACT 2003: THE OLD SORTING OFFICE, HAULEY ROAD, DARTMOUTH, TQ6 9AA

The Chairman advised that the applicants had agreed to reduce the terminal hour of opening, alcohol sales and late night refreshments on standard days by 30 minutes. Subsequently, the operating schedules had been amended after mediation with interested parties and it had been agreed that there should not be a formal hearing.
