Further to previous correspondence from us, we would like to support the alternative site for the Sherford New Community as proposed by the Plymouth and South West Co-operative Society. The new proposal saves the local playing fields at Haye Road which provide an enviable source of recreation land and are clearly in line with government policy to increase sporting activity within our community.

The new proposal addresses the concerns of the residents of Drunken Bridge Hill, who are concerned that the previously suggested site for the Sherford New Community with a road linking directly to Haye Road would increase traffic along Ridge Road and Drunken Bridge Hill. There are serious concerns already about the excess use of these roads as "rat runs" or short cuts and road safety is paramount to those of us with young children.

Please consider these remarks within the Consultation due to end on 10th October 2006.
