Subject: Objection to Plymco's revised plan for the Sherford Valley Development.

I would like to lodge my objection to Plymco's proposal for a change in the plan for the Sherford Development. The original plan showed a country park on the east side of the valley which would help preserve part of the beautiful valley and also serve as a boundary to prevent the spread eastwards of the development in the future (their proposal does not give a plan for future development however it leaves more unprotected land which is likely to be built on in the future). This new plan is too close to Brixton and Elburton and would have a major impact on both communities. The road plan would cause more congestion by joining the A379 where it is a single carriageway. Plymco's plan, also, does not provide a separate bus route unlike the Council's plan which is trying to encourage people onto public transport to reduce congestion problems. Surely the interests of one company should not be allowed to ruin a plan which was making the best out of a bad situation.
