Notice of Adoption of the Dartmouth Site Allocations Development Plan Document (DPD), Ivybridge Site Allocations DPD, Kingsbridge Site Allocations DPD, Totnes Site Allocations DPD and the Rural Areas Site Allocations DPD

South Hams District Council formally adopted the Site Allocations Development Plan Documents (DPD) on 10 February 2011. These documents form part of the South Hams Local Development Framework and allocate sites for new housing, employment and community facilities.

Any person aggrieved by these DPDs may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, on the ground that the document is not within the appropriate power or that a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Applications should be made within six weeks of the date of the adoption of the plan on 10 February 2011.
