Young Sportsperson of the Year

The Sport South Hams Young Sportsperson of the Year Awards aims to promote and honour the sporting achievements of young people in the district.

The Junior section will consist of two categories.

There will be awards for sporting excellence whereby, nominations can be made for individuals displaying high levels of performance within their sport. There will also be an award which recognises young sportspeople who have shown sporting endeavour and commitment. There are two age categories:- **Up to 11 years and 12 - 18 years**

Indomitable Spirit Award.

The Sport South Hams Indomitable Spirit Sportsperson of the Year Award aims to promote and honour the sporting achievements of disabled people in the district, recognising personal triumph and achievement. The Disabled section is open to Sports people of ALL AGES (defined by the British Sports Association for the Disabled as having a permanent functional, i.e. sensory, physical or learning impairment).

Junior U18 Team of the Year.

The Sport South Hams U18 Team of the Year Award aims to promote and honour the team which has made the greatest sporting achievement during the year.

Digger Cooper Commemorative Trophy.

The Digger Cooper Commemorative Award promotes and honours the sports club community 'champion' who has made the greatest contribution behind-the-scenes.

Club Members, Individual Coaches, Teachers and Volunteers all know the specific achievements of their individuals and teams within their Sport. To help the mechanism of deciding who receives an Award, Sport South Hams want to learn of your very best performers.

If you have an interest in sport, and know of someone who is worthy of nominating, please complete the form opposite. All nominated candidates must be affiliated to a Sport South Hams club or attend a school in the South Hams District or live within the District boundaries.

Please make no more than ONE nomination in each category and no more than THREE nominations in total regardless of category. This applies whether you are nominating individuals or teams.
