

## Matrix for Landscape and Visual Impact Assessment (LVIA) Requirements

### Notes:

1. Despite falling outside these criteria, development may require LVIA as part of an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). This will be subject to a separate screening exercise.
2. LVIAs should be proportionate to the development they are assessing, ranging from a full LVIA as part of EIA, to a short, focussed assessment of the impacts on a certain characteristic or view.
3. It is recommended that LVIAs are carried out by a qualified landscape architect, with reference to the Guidelines for Landscape and Visual Impact Assessment (LI/IEEMA 2013).
