

Business Parking Permit

Business Parking Permits for use in the Council's long stay car parks are issued subject to the following conditions:

1. Business Parking Permits may be used only in allocated car parks in the South Hams area. Parking Permits may not be used in any other car park.
2. Purchase of a Parking Permit **DOES NOT GUARANTEE THE RIGHT TO A SPACE** in any particular car park.
3. Parking Permits are invalid if vehicle is not taxed.
4. The Business Parking Permit must be displayed immediately upon receipt and must remain clearly visible in the windscreen at all times when the vehicle is parked in a Council car park. Failure to display a valid Permit will render the motorist liable to incur a penalty charge.
5. Photocopied business permits are not accepted under any circumstances.
6. Please note that purchase of a Business Parking Permit does not entitle the bearer to the use of a **RESERVED** bay.
7. Please note that the following rules and regulations apply to all users of South Hams District Council car parks and are displayed on the notice boards:
 - No caravans, trailers, lorries, boats permitted, nor any other vehicle that do not fit in a marked bay.
 - No overnight sleeping.
 - Park wholly within marked bays only.
 - Valid ticket must be displayed at all times.
 - Vehicles and their contents are parked at owners risk and the District Council will accept no liability for loss or damage to vehicles or contents.

Penalty Charge for Non-Compliance £70

8. **NON-COMPLIANCE WITH ANY OF THE ABOVE CAN BE CONSTRUED AS FRAUDULENT USE OF THE PARKING PERMIT AND MAY RESULT IN THE ISSUE OF A PENALTY CHARGE OF £70, THE PARKING PERMIT BEING WITHDRAWN AND NO FURTHER PARKING PERMITS BEING ISSUED FOR TWO YEARS FROM THE DATE WHEN THE PERMIT IS WITHDRAWN. DURING THIS PERIOD THE SITUATION WILL BE MONITORED AND ANY PARKING OFFENCES WILL BE NOTED AND USED AS EVIDENCE WHEN CONSIDERING FUTURE APPLICATIONS FOR A PERMIT.**
9. We reserve the right to refuse any application for a Parking Permit.
10. Parking permits may not be sold onto or rented out to a third party by the Parking Permit Holder at the intended or increased price under any circumstances.
11. Business permits are issued in the business name and are permitted to be transferred between that business's vehicles only.
