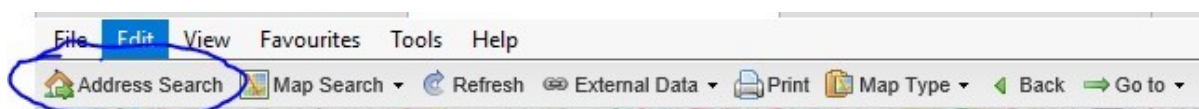
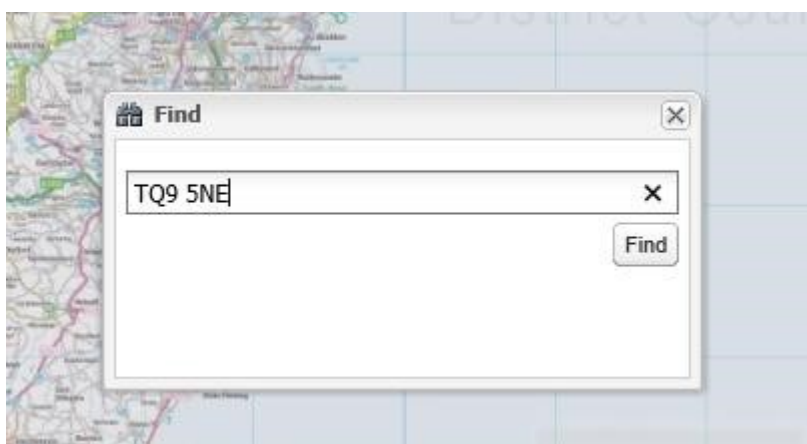


# How to Use Interactive Mapping

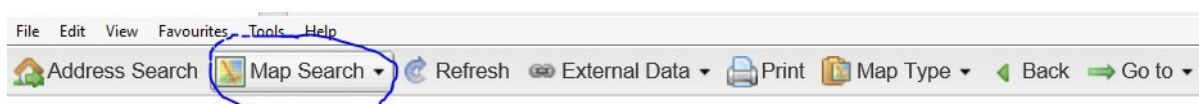
1. Open the Interactive Mapping Link
2. Click on “address search” in the top left of the page.



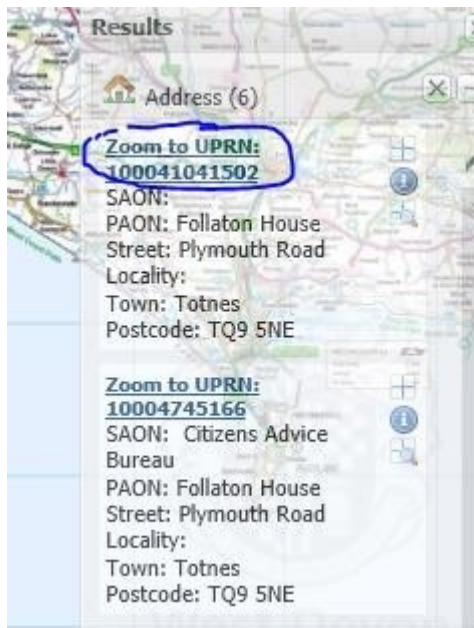
3. Search for the address of the tree(s) using the nearest postcode by entering the postcode in the pop up box, then clicking on “Find.”



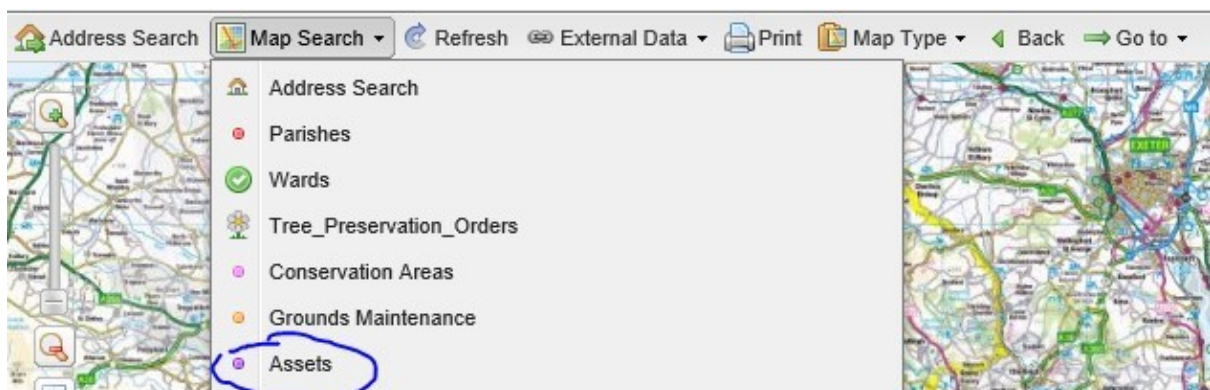
4. The screen will change to a map of the postcode area. Click on the “Map Search” button at the top of the page – it is next to the Address Search Button that you used in Step 2.



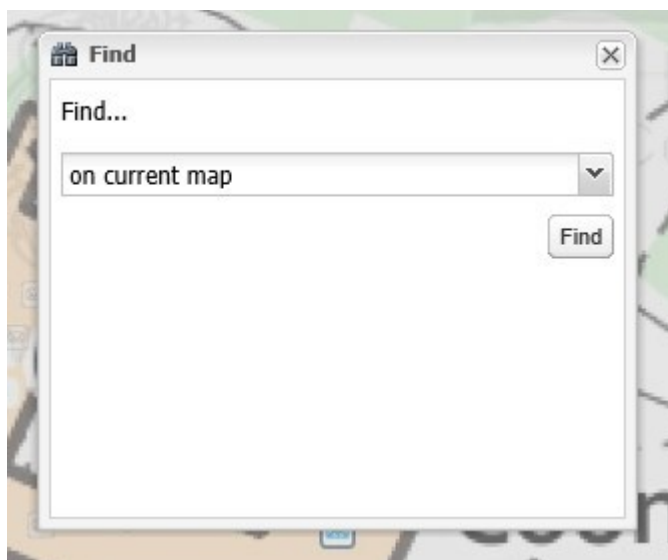
5. A list of addresses will appear on the right side of the screen.
6. The address have a link above them which reads “Zoom to UPRN”. Find the address you are looking for in the list and click on this link. You can zoom in and out using the magnifier on the left side of the map.



7. To view trees or land owned by South Hams or West Devon Councils, click "Map Search" again and select "Assets" from the drop-down list.



8. A pop up box will appear. Make sure that "on current map" is selected from the drop-down list and then click "Find."



9. Trees or land belonging to South Hams District Council are shown in red, while trees belonging to West Devon Borough Council are shown in green.
