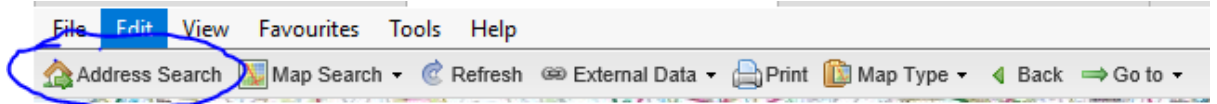


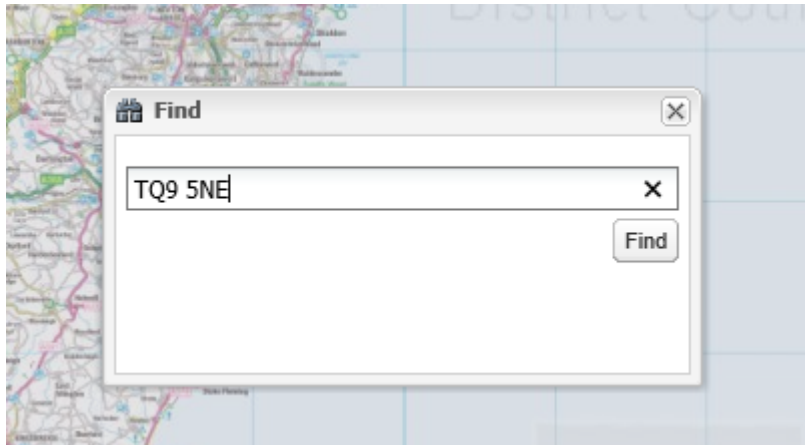
## Find out if a tree is in a Conservation Area

To find out if a tree is located within a Conservation Area, please carry out a map search of the “Conservation Areas” layer on our [interactive mapping](#). Once you have opened the link, follow the instructions below:

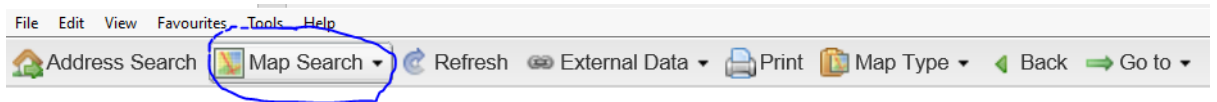
1. Open the link: [Interactive mapping](#)
2. Search for the address of the trees using the nearest postcode



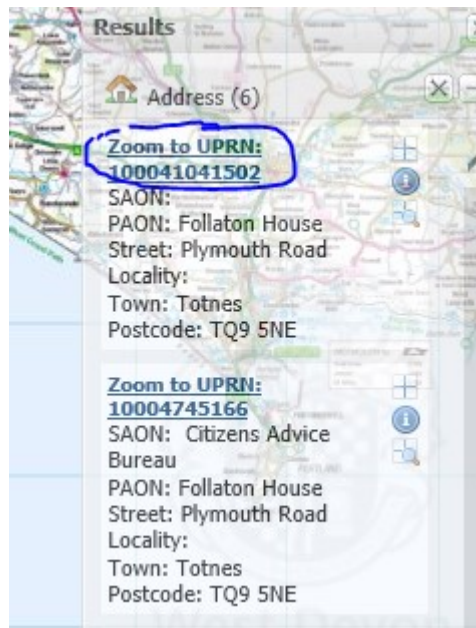
3. Add the postcode in the pop-up box, then click on ‘Find’



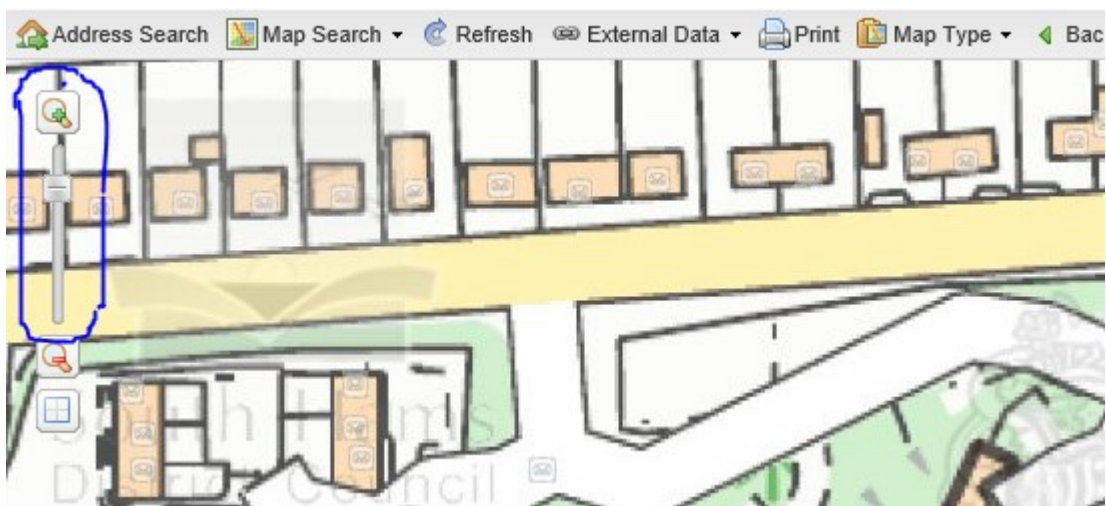
4. When the map of the postcode area appears, click on the identified button:



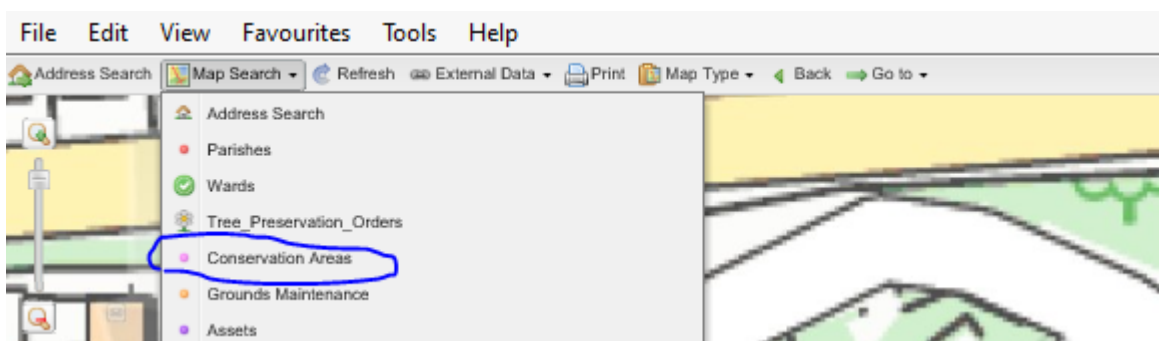
5. A list of addresses will appear on the right hand side. Click on the blue underlined writing most relevant to your search, e.g.:



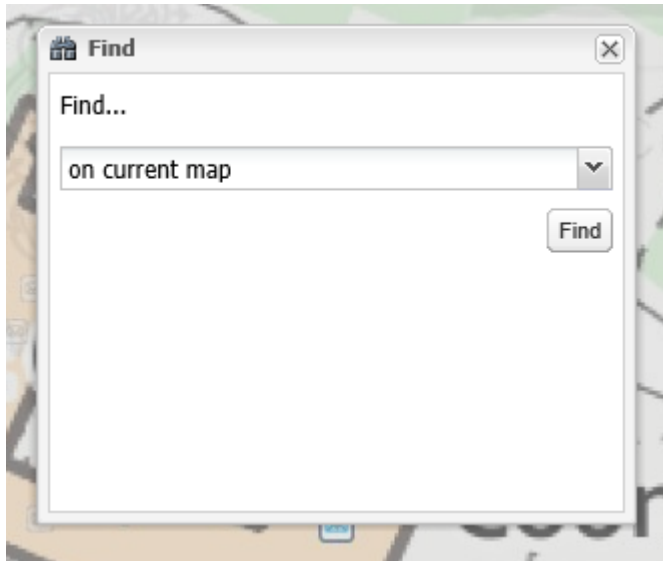
6. Zoom in or out as required using your mouse



7. Click on 'Map Search' Select 'Conservation Areas'



8. Select 'on current map' from dropdown menu, then click 'Find'



9. Click on the blue link on the search results. Conservation Areas will show in bright pink.
